VIDYARTHI SAHAYYAK SAMITI

Dear Sir/ Madam,

It gives me immense pleasure to have a dialogue with you as a donor, guardian and well wisher of Samiti. I would like to apprise you of Samiti's working and some changes during the current financial year.

- 1. Construction of the Indira Wing on the fourth floor of Sumitra Sadan was completed from the concept and donation of Shri P.B.Kulkarni, ex-Chairman of Bank of Maharashtra and a well wisher of Samiti. The wing has 7 rooms which can accommodate 25 girl students.
- 2. Shri Girish Bapat, Guardian Minister of Pune district, has helped Samiti to get wheat and rice from the Central Government quota through the food grains distribution section. This has resulted in a substantial reduction in expenses for Samiti.
- 3. Expenses on gas, electricity, water, employees were increasing as there were three kitchens in Samiti's four hostels. Since piped gas, which is cheaper, is available only in Lajpatrai Bhavan Hostel, it was decided to operate only one kitchen in Lajpatrai Bhavan and supply food to the other two hostels from there. This is expected to save Rs. 12 lakh per annum in expenses.
- 4. Since Samiti attaches great importance to the concept of personality development, a group of ex-students has started working with the present students. Many things in operations are becoming simpler as a result of the dialogue between the ex-students and the present students. Participation of ex-students in the operations has increased. With ex-students participating in Samiti's work as Karyakartas and trustees, it would not be incorrect to say that Samiti has become younger.
- 5. Referring to the Income and Expenditure Statement it would be observed that there is a surplus of Rs. 45 lakh. This amount is the interest on the term deposits over the last four years, hence it should not be considered as income of the last financial year alone. In fact, having regard to the increasing expenditure, there is deficit of Rs. 8.82 lakh during the last financial year. Karyakartas, employees and ex-students have been working continuously to bridge this gap. Keeping this in view, ex-students have pledged to raise funds by taking inspiration from Samiti's trustee and ex-rector Shri Ramakant Tamboli.
- 6. We have plans to start some project on the vacant land of Lajpat Bhavan. The idea is to supplement Samiti's income and make it stronger. Part of this land was under government reservation, but the process of withdrawing it has started. The idea is to use part of the land for a project which would get income for Samiti, part for skill development projects and part would be used as play ground.
- 7. In view of the increase in Samiti's work, a post of Chief Executive Officer has been created. Shri Prabhakar Patil, ex-student has been appointed in this post. Apart from looking after the day to day operations of Samiti, he is responsible for liaisoning with Charity Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Food distribution and other departments and all the pending jobs have been completed.
- 8. Samiti has complied with all the requirements of the minimum wages act for employees. Samiti attaches great importance to the employees' contribution in this social work.

9. With increase in the capacity of the hostels over the last few years the number of students has gone up. However, we are still unable to admit many more students. From this, we notice that many students are in need of the facilities provided by Samiti. Hence the management is considering whether it would be feasible to extend Samiti's work to rural areas. Proposals in that connection have been received from Ahmednagar and Baramati and are under consideration.

To sum up, the mission for education of rural students started 62 years ago is continuing day and night. We are conscious that this has been possible only due to the cooperation of many like you who are conscious of their social sensitivities. Your suggestions and feedback would always be welcome and so would be your contribution for the future projects .

THE EARN & LEARN SCHEME

The objective of this scheme is that students should earn some money by doing some work so as to reduce the financial burden of their parents. While working, they also get to learn conversational skills, self reliance and social awareness. A multicoloured guide was prepared under the guidance of Dr. Tej Niwalikar. The students earned Rs. 21,05,242/- under this scheme during the year.

Additionally, the students earned Rs. 2,19,655/- by doing occasional work for Sakal Social Foundation, Foundation for Ancient Indian Philosophy and Medicine, Nishant Publications, Vidyasagar Classes, Market yard Agri Solutions, Star Forum, Franklin Institute, Hitendra Advertising and others.

Rewards of Rs. 600/- each and commendation certificates were awarded to 10 girls in the memory of Smt. Usha Balwant Deshpande.

OTHER IMPORTANT DEVELOPMENTS IN HOSTELS

AROGYA KENDRA

In accordance with the practice every year, medical examination of all the resident and non-resident students was carried out. In general, the health was satisfactory. In some cases the height was less in relation to the weight and haemoglobin level was lower than normal. A few students were advised to get some special tests done. All the students were briefed about regular diet and exercise, personal and general hygiene, Ygasanas, Soorya Namaskar, Pranayama and meditation, skin diseases, adverse effects of junk food, stress and time management, menstruation, sex education, AIDS etc.

Ophthalmologist Dr. Varsha Kulkarni, Dermatologist Dr. Vidyasagar Ghate, Om Hospital, Ratna Hospital, Sahyadri Hospital, Deen Dayal Hospital, Sassoon Hospital, Tarachand Hospital extended cooperation during the year. All the Health Centres in the hostels were renovated and new medical equipment procured from the donation given by Dr. Jagannath Vani was installed. Dr. Prasad Ambikar and Dr. Supriya Vyawahare are the medical officers. They are assisted by students from the medical faculty.

SAHAYYA SANKALAN (COLLECTION OF DONATIONS)

Presently, two plans are available : (1) Persons who offer donations of Rs, 1,000/every year are called Guardians (Paalak), (2) Persons offering a one time donation of Rs. 5,000/- or moreare called Special Guardians (Vishesh Paalak).

Some Paalaks express desire to have interaction with students regularly. In such cases, one or two students are deputed to meet them every month and they get guidance from them in various matters. As of end March 2018, donations received from Guardians totalled Rs. 37,63,922/- and other donations received were Rs. 1,65,77,416/- The total number of Guardians was 2204.

14 students, boys and girls, from Samiti hostel,s did a good job of collecting donations from donors from Pune.

During the last several years, a gathering of donors, guardians and well wishers of Samiti is regularly organised in the evening on 26th January. This year, the gathering was arranged at Lajpatrai Bhavan and was attended by about 250 to 300 guardians, donors and well wishers. The students had organised an exhibition of drawings, rangoli and science experiments on this ocasion. The students also gave demonstration of yogasanas.

In November every year, a classical music concert is organised for Samiti's donors, guardians and well wishers. This year, a classical music programme of Smt. Veena Joglekar was organised on 11th November in the hall of Apte Hostel. It was attended by about 250-300 people.

It is only with the support of these people that Samiti has been able to carry on its work over the years. Sincere thanks to all the donors and well wishers. We are confident that their support would continue in future too. The list of donors and guardians is given elsewhere in this report.
